## Exam Site Information for Candidates 2021 WREB Dental Hygiene Examinations

### 1. School Facility and Services

 Location, Building Access and Hours: Southwestern College Higher Education Center at National City is located at 880 National City Boulevard in National City, California. Dental Hygiene Clinic is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Room 7217. Building is open 6:00am-6:00pm daily for duration of exam.

### 2. Preparing for the <u>Hygiene Exam</u>

- Patient Screening: Contact Gay Teel (619-216-6670) regarding clinic availability.
- **Radiographs:** Candidates are required to provide their own x-rays for this exam. Southwestern College has digital radiography available for emergency use only.
- Sterilization Services: Southwestern College does <u>not</u> provide onsite sterilization services.
- Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials: Refer to WREB Candidate Guide for a list of materials and armamentarium that the Candidate must provide.
  - **A. Hand piece and Prophy Angle Hookups:** Two Hole Coupler and Midwest RDH handpiece. Contact Gay Teel (619-216-6670) regarding availability.
  - **B.** Sonic/Ultrasonic Devices: WREB allows the use of sonic/ultrasonic devices as an adjunct to calculus removal. All operatories are equipped for hookup of the following compatible devices: Cavitron, Swerv, Piezo. Southwestern College does <u>not</u> have equipment available for loan or rent at this time.
  - C. Air/Water Syringe Tips: Syringe tips are disposable.
  - **D. Blood Pressure Cuffs and Stethoscopes:** Candidates must provide their own blood pressure cuffs or stethoscopes. Southwestern College does <u>not</u> have equipment available for loan or rent.
  - E. Expendable Materials: Expendable dental materials supplied by the school are noted in *Appendix A* (items not listed are responsibility of Candidate).

### 3. During the Clinical Exam

- **Dental Operatory Units**: A-Dec 1021 Decade (Chair), A-Dec delivery system 2122 Cascade
- Infection Control (Surface Asepsis): Refer to OSHA clinical asepsis protocols pertinent to the exam (i.e. dental unit, countertops, patient chair, light handles, etc.); additional information provided at exam site.
  - A. Hazardous Waste Disposal:
    - **Hygiene:** Refer to OSHA clinical procedure for disposal of blood/saliva-soaked waste; additional information provided at exam site.
  - B. Sharps Disposal: Sharps containers are located throughout the clinic.
- Emergency Medical Equipment: Oxygen is available at Chairs 1 and 13. The AED is located in clinic as well as first aid kit.

COVID 19 UPDATE: Candidates must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and must have finished the series at least 2 weeks prior to exam day. A current vaccine card - showing 2 doses, or 1 dose with J&J - will be required upon entrance. If a Candidate has not been fully vaccinated, a negative Covid test within 72 hours of arrival will be required.
