

FACULTY INSTRUCTIONS FOR

2022 WREB EXAM OBSERVATION APPLICATION

Each year, WREB invites dental hygiene educators and faculty to observe a clinical exam. We understand the benefit of observing the examination process in person and seek to provide selected observers with a quality experience that they can share with other faculty members and key staff at their school.

Observer Assignment includes:

- All Examiner Workshop (AEW) & Onsite Calibration Exercises, *day of* or *prior to* first clinical exam date
- Examiner Grading Session, generally first Clinical exam date
- Candidate Examination Session, generally first Clinical exam date
- Candidate Q&A Session and/or Clinic Tour (optional), dependent on exam schedule

Selected Observers:

- Are notified of their tentative exam assignment via email**
- Will receive their *exam observation schedule* via email approximately 3-4 weeks prior to the clinical exam
- Share the benefit of their observation experience with administration and faculty at their school

APPLICATION DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 12, 2021

Keep the following in mind when making your selections:

- Space is limited to maintain exam integrity and flow
- Limit one representative per school per year
- Limit one exam type per location
- Limit one exam every five years
- Faculty members cannot observe at locations where their students are testing
- Individuals are responsible for any expenses incurred
- Select only those locations/dates that you are able to attend**
- Select up to five (5) locations in order of preference (ex. 1 = most desired location)

**Exam dates and times subject to change based on enrollment.
