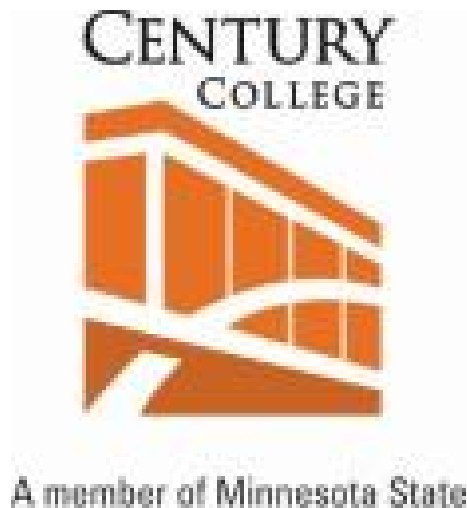

1. School Facility and Services

- **Location, Building Access and Hours:**
Century College Dental Hygiene Clinic, 3300 Century Avenue North, White Bear Lake, MN 55110 East Campus E3651, 651-779-5787.

Directions to Clinic: After entering the building, go to the third floor. There is signage to direct to the Dental Clinic. Building is open 6:30am - 6:00pm daily for duration of exam.
- **Parking:** Candidates and patients: Please consult parking map. Park in Lot F or G. There is no fee for parking, no parking passes required.
- **Security and Emergency Services:** Century College Security Services will be available at all times during the test. Phone: 651-747-4000.
- **ATM Machine:** An ATM machine can be found on the first floor near the West elevator.
- **Food Services Onsite:** There are no cafeteria resources available. Vending machines can be found on the first, second and third floors.

2. Preparing for the Hygiene Exam

- **Patient Screening:** Students will have access to patient screening resources at Community Dental Care, either during your clinical time or as arranged through your instructor and the staff at Community Dental Care.
- **Radiographs:** Candidates are required to provide x-rays for exam, however, access to x-ray machine and developer easily accessible to the clinic floor may be required for backup patients. All imaging completed at Community Dental Care and Century College is digital. There is no candidate or patient fee from images. Images taken at Community Dental Care can be emailed for printing to dental.hygiene@century.edu.
- **Administration of Local Anesthetic:** Practitioner(s) from the school is **NOT AVAILABLE** to administer local anesthesia to Candidate Patients. There are no exceptions to this policy.
- **Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials:** Refer to the respective WREB Candidate Guide for a list of materials and armamentarium that the Candidate must provide.
 - A. **Handpiece and Propy Angle Hookups:** Century College will provide handpieces and propy angles free of charge to all candidates for use during the test.
 - B. **Sonic/Ultrasonic Devices:** Every unit is equipped with a Cavitron ultrasonic unit. Ultrasonic instrument inserts will be available at no charge to candidates. Inserts include the Cavitron triple bend, beaver tail, and Thinsert. Candidates may bring a 30K insert if they prefer one not provided by the college.
 - C. **Air/Water Syringe Tips:** Air/water syringe tips are provided by the college. Some units have disposable, some reusable. You will be provided tips and instruction on use and disposal based on the unit assigned to you.
 - D. **Blood Pressure Cuffs and Stethoscopes:** Candidates will need to bring their own blood pressure measuring device. In the event of malfunction there is a machine at the college for backup use.

E. Expendable Materials: Expendable dental materials supplied by the school are noted in *Appendix A*.

- **Sterilization Services:** Sterilization services will be provided to candidates needing to retest.

3. During the Clinical Exam

- **Dental Operatory Units:** There are both DentalEZ and ADEC chairs in the dental clinic. Students will be provided a brief orientation to the unit they are assigned and instruction on usage before beginning and support during the examination.

- **Infection Control (Surface Asepsis):** Barriers will be provided for dental chairs, light handles, and other direct contact surfaces. Counter surfaces will be cleaned with Cavi-wipes.

A. Hazardous Waste Disposal (exam-type specific):

- **Hygiene:** Hazardous waste bags will be available for use if required. Any hazardous waste generated is handled by Century College Campus Security by calling x4000.

- **Sharps Disposal:** Sharps containers are in each dental unit. All needles can be deposited into the unit Sharps container. Local anesthetic cartridges that contain either no epinephrine or agent with epinephrine that is fully dispensed can be disposed of in the unit Sharps container. Cartridges with residual agent containing epinephrine will be collected in a disposable cup to be put into the Black Box. Candidates will be asked to inform the clinical support team of agent needing to be disposed of in the Black Box.

- **Emergency Medical Equipment:** An emergency kit and portable oxygen can be found at the East End of the clinic and clearly marked. There is an AED on the third floor of the college near E3501. In the event of an emergency, EMS can be summoned by dialing 9-911. In the event a call is made, inform the agency that you are calling from Century College East Campus, Washington County, third floor dental clinic. Century College Public Safety is notified anytime a 911 call is placed and will respond in cooperation with outside emergency services. Specify location of emergency equipment (i.e. oxygen, AED, first aid kits, ice packs, etc.) and procedure used in case of an emergency (e.g. contact information, dialing instructions).

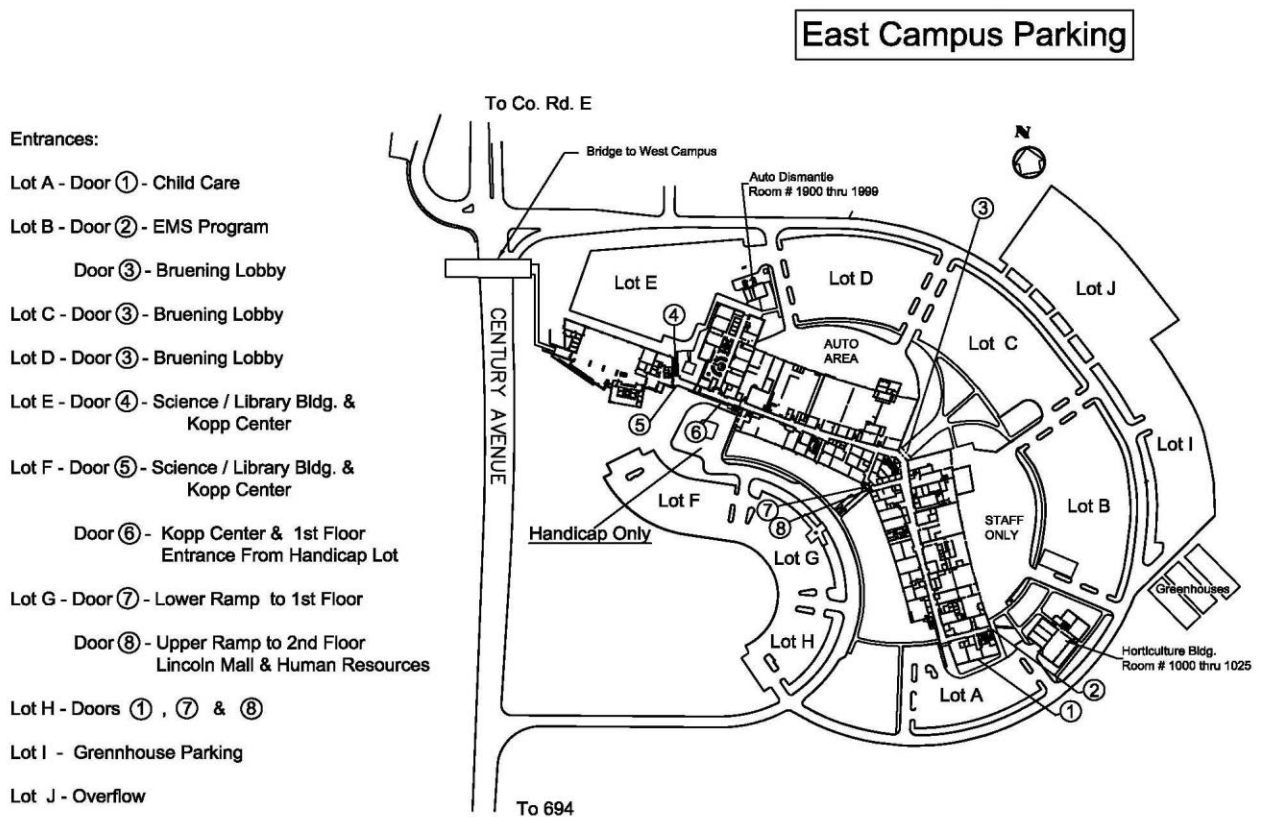
