2. Preparing for the Exams

a. Local Anesthesia Exam

- **Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials:** Refer to the respective WREB Candidate Guide for a list of materials and armamentarium that the Candidate must provide.
 - A. Air/Water Syringe Tips:** Air/Water syringe tips are disposable and will be available
 - B. Expendable Materials:** Expendable dental materials supplied by the school are noted in *Appendix B*.
- **Sterilization Services:** Sterilization services are available

3. During the Clinical Exam

- **Dental Operatory Units:** Belmont ExCaliber Chairs.
- **Infection Control (Surface Asepsis):** Barriers and surface disinfectants will be provided
 - A. Hazardous Waste Disposal (exam-type specific):**
 - **Local Anesthesia:** Hazardous waste disposal located in Sterilization lab
 - B. Sharps Disposal:** Sharps containers located between each two chairs. Capped needles and LA cartridges allowed in sharps containers
- **Emergency Medical Equipment:** First Aid equipment located in mini-lab in the main clinic area. AED mounted on wall outside of mini-lab. Emergency protocol binders located between each two operatories.

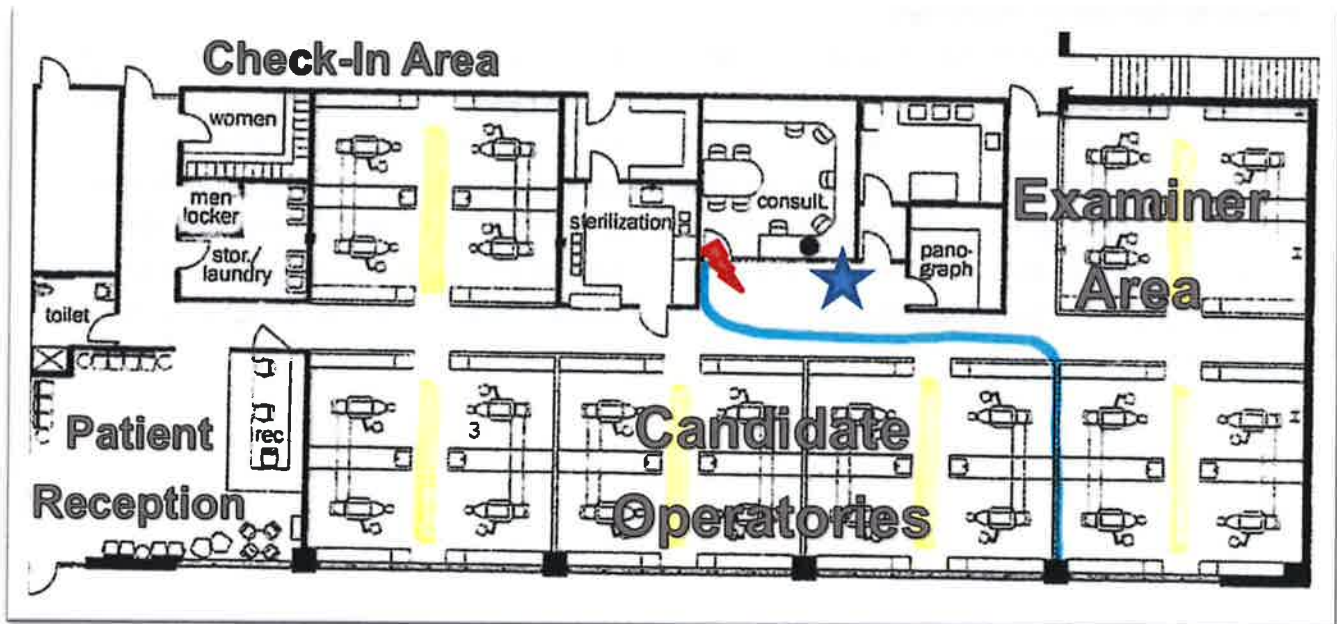
- **Blue line** represents barrier curtains.
- Operatories on the right side of the blue line are the **examiner area**.
- Operatories on the left side of the blue line are **candidate operatories**.
- **Patient reception room** is located on the far left lower corner.
- The hallway located just outside the top of the map is the **check-in area**.



- **Blue star** notes location of emergency binder, emergency first aid kit and emergency oxygen.

Airport Information

Lodging: Hotel/Motel

Food & Beverage Services

Dixie State University has no food, beverage, or cafeteria services for candidates or their patients except for a couple of vending machines. Candidates should inform their patients to eat before coming to the exam or candidates may choose to bring a small amount of food and beverage for their patients that the on-site **school coordinator can refrigerate and then retrieve for them** when it is needed. There are many gas stations, restaurants, fast food establishments, and a grocery store located within one (1) mile of the clinic if you wish to purchase food. However, **food or drink are not allowed in any areas** near the candidate clinics or check in desk during the examination.
