## 1. School Facility and Services

- **Location, Building Access and Hours:** The School of Dental Hygiene Studies is located on the second floor of Hillsboro Campus Building 1. The physical address for this building is 222 SE 8th Avenue, Hillsboro, OR 97123 (734) 834-7644 Amy Coplen; building open 6:00am-6:00pm daily for duration of exam.

### a. Restorative Exam

  - A. Handpieces and Prophy Angel Hookups:** We use 6-pin gasket type handpiece attachment. Candidates are encouraged to bring their own, but we will have some available to loan, but will need to be checked by staff on site prior to candidate leaving the cubicle to ensure nothing is accidentally taken by the candidate.
  - B. Air/Water Syringe Tips:** Disposable and extra are available.
  - C. Curing Lights:** Curing lights are available and do have shields

#### Driving Directions

The Hillsboro Campus (HC) of Pacific University is located in Hillsboro, Oregon, 18 miles west of downtown Portland. From Portland, the preferred route to campus is via Highway 26 (Sunset Highway). Proceed west on Highway 26 and take Exit 62A – South Cornelius Pass Road. Travel south approximately 1 mile to Cornell Road. Turn right onto Cornell Road and travel approximately 5 miles to Washington Street in Hillsboro. Cornell Road becomes 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Hillsboro. Turn right onto Washington Street. Travel west on Washington Street two blocks.

HC Building 2 will be on your right at the northeast corner of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Washington Street. The address is 190 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Hillsboro, OR 97123

HC Building 1 will be on your left at the southeast corner of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Washington Street. The address is 222 SE 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Hillsboro, OR 97123.

#### Visitor Parking

Visitor parking is available on the first two floors of the Intermodal Transit Facility which is located on the northwest corner of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Baseline. Two-hour street parking is available in the residential neighborhood around the campus. Please be courteous and observe parking limits.

#### Public Transportation

The Hillsboro Campus is located on the Tri-Met MAX light rail line at the Tuality Hospital stop, 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Washington Street in Hillsboro. The HC is accessible from Portland International Airport and from anywhere within the Portland Metropolitan Region via Tri-Met bus and MAX service. 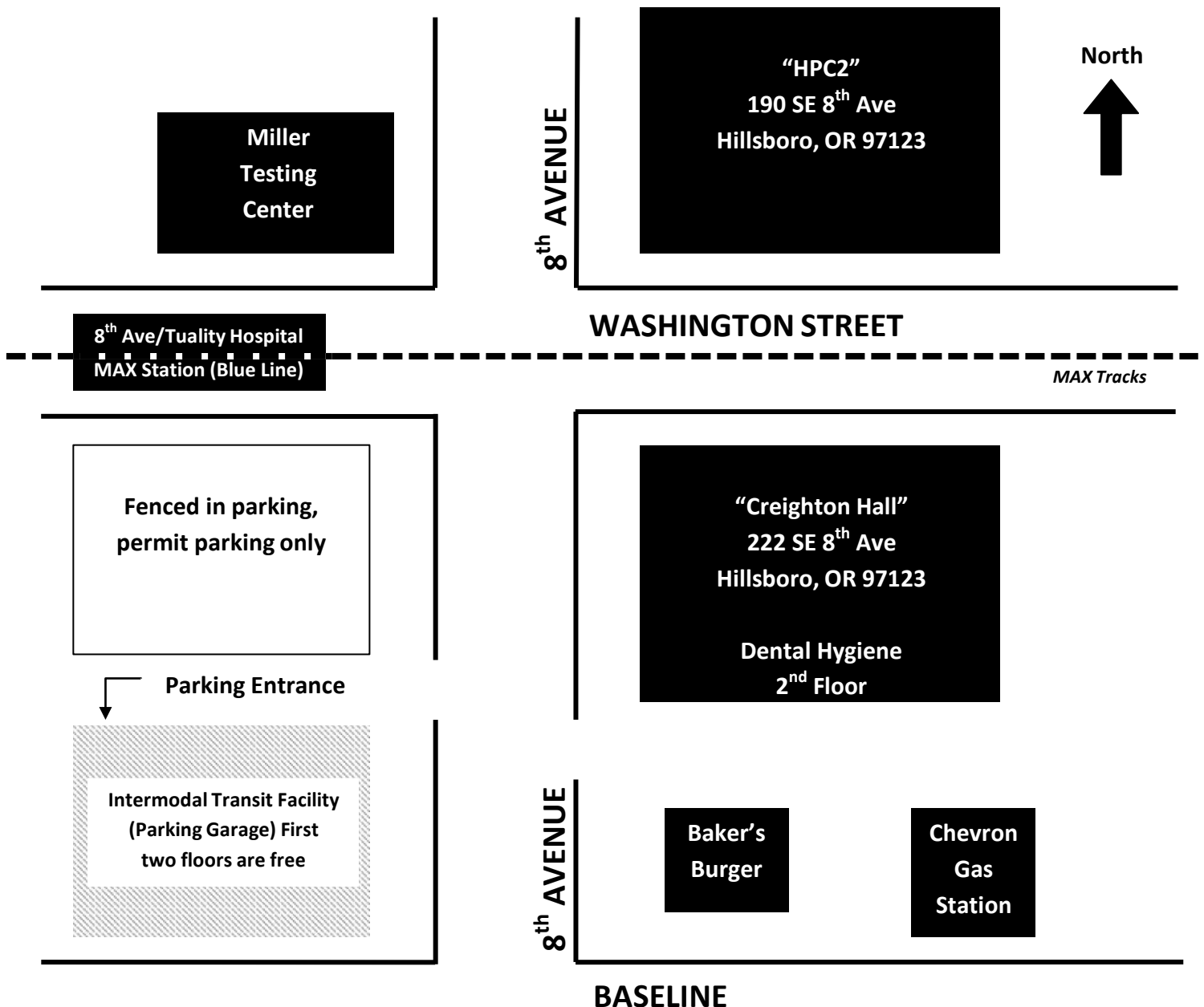


## Map of Health Professions Campus Hillsboro, Oregon

**Driving:** From Portland International Airport, follow signs to and enter I-205 S. After approximately 3 miles, take exit 21B to merge onto I-84 W/US-30 W toward Portland. Travel on I-84W for 5 miles and take the I-5 S exit towards Beaverton/Salem. Continue on to I-405 N (signs for US-26/City Center/Beaverton). Take exit 1D to merge onto US-26 W towards Beaverton. After 10 miles, take exit 62A for Cornelius Pass Road South. Merge onto NW Cornelius Pass Road and turn right at NE Cornell Road. Travel 4 miles and turn right on E Main St. Take the second left onto SE 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue (you will be heading south). Creighton Hall will be on your left immediately after Washington Street.

**Public Transportation:** Tri-Met operates the MAX, which is the Portland area's light rail system. The Blue Line runs from Gresham (east of Portland) all the way to Hillsboro. The 8<sup>th</sup> Ave/Tuality Hospital station is approximately 100 feet from Creighton Hall. Please check [www.trimet.org](http://www.trimet.org) for travel planning.

**Parking:** Residential street parking is available. The Intermodal Transit Facility (Parking Garage) opened in September 2010 and is on the corner of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Baseline. The first two floors are open for parking.
