1. School Facility and Services

Location, Building Access and Hours:

2. Preparing for the Exams

a. **Hygiene Exam**

Patient Screening:

- Carrington College Dental Hygiene Department cannot provide patients for candidates. Candidates should not ask the school for patients or patients' records. Candidates may use the Dental Hygiene clinic to screen patients on a limited basis, by appointment, and prior to exam week.
- Times will be determined as needed.
- Please call to schedule an appointment. All screenings and radiographs must be completed prior to the arrival of WREB examiners.

NO SCREENINGS ARE ALLOWED DURING THE WREB EXAM DATES

Radiographs:

- This site is a digital facility only. Sensors and XCP's will be made available as needed.
- Viewing boxes available upon request
- Candidates needing to use the Radiology clinic are required to follow Carrington
 College infection control policies and to wear proper clinic attire.
- Staff will be available to facilitate and answer questions about the equipment.
- The candidate will be responsible for exposing, scanning, and mounting their patient's images.

Administration of Local Anesthetic:

- Practitioner(s) (meeting prescribed criteria as stated in the Candidate Guide) will be AVAILABLE during the exam to administer local anesthesia to all Candidate Patients. To be fair to all candidates, the practitioner(s) will be available throughout every day of the exam.
- There is no charge for this service.

Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials:

A. Handpiece and Prophy Angle Hookups: Each Unit is equipped with:

- a Pro 31 Front Delivery Unit.
- All units have a quick-connector water and air source
- Handpieces / Air motors are available for loan
- Candidates borrowing equipment will be required to submit a valid credit which will be returned to candidate upon return of equipment
- Please notify school representative at time of Q &A session of individual needs for equipment loan.



B. Sonic/Ultrasonic Devices:

- All units have:
 - 1. Dentsply (30K) Ultrasonic Cavitron with sleeve for candidate use
 - 2. quick-connector water and air source



C. Air/Water Syringe Tips:

• Air/Water syringe tips are disposable and are supplied by school, at no charge

D. Blood Pressure Cuffs and Stethoscopes:

- Candidates should bring their own BP cuff and stethoscope
- **E. Expendable Materials:** Expendable dental materials supplied by the school are noted in *Appendix A*.

Sterilization Services:

- Instrument and hand pieces, properly sanitized, dried, wrapped, and marked with appropriate candidate identification will be accepted for steam sterilization.
- Sterilization services are available from 8AM- 5PM. Instruments received after
 3:00 will not be ready until 11AM the following day.

b. Local Anesthesia Exam:

Equipment, Instruments and Expendable Dental Materials: Refer to the respective WREB Candidate Guide for a list of materials and armamentarium that the Candidate must provide.


A. Air/Water Syringe Tips:

- Air/Water syringe tips are disposable and are supplied by school
- **B. Expendable Materials:** Expendable dental materials supplied by the school are noted in *Appendix B.*
- Sterilization Services: Syringes, locking pliers/hemostats, properly sanitized, dried, wrapped, and marked with appropriate candidate identification will be accepted for steam sterilization.
 - Sterilization Services are available from 8AM- 5PM. Instruments received after 3:00 will not be ready until 11AM the following day
 - Candidates retaking exam, onsite, will be accommodated either with sterilization of personal equipment or issued loaned equipment from the school. There is no charge for loaned equipment.

3. During the Clinical Exam

Dental Operatory Units:

 Each cubicle is equipped with a dental chair (NuStar Hydraulic). A delivery unit equipped with an air/water syringe, Dentsply Ultrasonic Cavitron units (30K) and an operator's stool. Any equipment malfunctions should be reported immediately to the Chief Examiner.



• Infection Control (Surface Asepsis):

- Handles of unit light and air-water syringes may be covered with either clear plastic barriers or adhesive plastic wrap.
- The dental unit and counter tops may be disinfected by using Cavi-wipes
- The dental chair will be covered with a large clear plastic bag. If the chair needs

to be decontaminated, the candidates will use soapy water.

- All wraps for units will be available in each bay.
- Utility Gloves are available in each bay

A. Hazardous Waste Disposal (exam-type specific):

- Hygiene: Any blood/saliva-soaked waste is considered hazardous and MUST be disposed of in biohazard receptacles located in each bay
- Local Anesthesia: Any blood/saliva-soaked waste is considered hazardous and MUST be disposed of in biohazard receptacles located in each bay.
- **B. Sharps Disposal:** All needles, anesthetic cartridges and any potential sharps are to be safely placed in the sharp's container located in each cubicle

Emergency Medical Equipment:

- There are (2) oxygen tanks located outside of Bay A- B and Bay B-C
- During WREB examination an additional oxygen tank will be located in the Examiners' area- Bay D-E
- o Pocket Ventilation masks are located in each of the (5) bays
- an Emergency Kit and Emergency Equipment is located on counter outside of Radiology area
- o The Automatic External Defibrillator Units are located:
 - 1 is mounted to wall, located outside of sterilization
 - 1 is mounted to wall, in the hallway next to patient lavatory

4. Travel and Lodging Information

Airport Information: Mesa is served by two airports: Phoenix Sky Harbor and Mesa Gateway Airport. Phoenix Sky Harbor is approximately 10 miles from the dental hygiene facility and Mesa Gateway airport is 15 miles from the facility. Phoenix Sky Harbor is the larger airport and services most airlines with many flights a day.

Depending on origination, candidates may find flights into both airports and should inquire when booking reservations.

• Ground Transportation:

In non-rush hour periods, expect a minimum drive time of 15-20 minutes.

Start out going East on Sky Harbor Blvd. 2.2 miles

Merge onto AZ-202-Loop toward Tempe. 4.2 miles

Merge onto AZ-101-Loop South via EXIT 9. 3 miles

Take the US-60 E exit, EXIT 55 toward Globe 3 miles

Take the AZ-87/Country Club Dr exit, EXIT 179 toward Chandler. .3 mile

Turn left onto S. Country Club Dr. .4 mile

1300 S. Country Club Drive is on the left (behind McDonalds and Starbucks)


